- We would prefer to have some food than no food. This is all that we can request, if SGA didn't fund us this is the amount that we can fund ourselves.
- Bee: On RAF listed charge of UMBC fees for \$2. Could you explain that?
- it is \$5 for students and, \$7 for guests. Money used to pay for Glenmore of SGA did not fund us for food
- Bee: Unfortunately, not allowed to charge UMBC students.

- Sara: If you're having an open event, you can only bring foods that are at low risks (baked sales stuff, prepackaged).
- Trent: The role of your food?
- It is a formal gala so it is necessary to have food.
- Trent: If board decides to partially fund the food, how low could the org go?
- At least half of it
- Trent: What's the role of the plaques?
- It is an award ceremony, so the plaques are needed to give out awards. It'd be weird to honor someone without a physical representation.
- Trent: We do have limited amount of funds, we are trying to see what's the lowest org's can go tonight. If the board can partially fund, which part of request can you fund on your own?

- Trent: In favor of fully funding for food because the nature of the event is typical to have food. I agree with Bee about Plaques, although it is used to recognize the six people it is not open to everyone. Against decorations but fully funded of food
- Anthony: I agree with fully funding with the food but not the plaques.
